Dear Family and Friends,

We learned today that a resident who was sent to Pen Bay Medical Center following a fall last evening has tested positive for COVID-19 as part of their hospital admission screening.

There are now two confirmed cases of COVID-19 among residents at Woodlands Memory Care of Rockland – both of whom remain in the hospital (as of this writing) for treatment of unrelated conditions. This makes a total of 3 cases (2 residents and 1 staff) of COVID-19 identified since Friday.

The second round of on-site collection of specimens for universal testing of all staff and all residents was successfully completed this morning and the specimens have been delivered to the Maine Health and Environmental Testing Lab in Augusta. The results should be available within the next 48 hours.

Resident health and safety is our absolute top priority as we continue to work through our COVID-19 response plan in anticipation of the potential identification of additional positive results among staff and residents in the specimens submitted today.
