Dear family and friends,

I am pleased to report that late yesterday the Maine CDC officially classified the Woodlands Memory Care of Rockland COVID-19 case as **closed**.

In order for a senior living community's outbreak to be considered as "closed" by the Maine CDC, 28 days must pass after onset of symptoms of last case with no additional cases. According to the Maine CDC, a person is no longer considered active once they have passed 10 days from the initial onset of symptoms and are no longer exhibiting any symptoms associated with COVID-19 or for individuals who remain asymptomatic their positive test date.

Woodlands Memory Care of Rockland was able to close the last individual COVID-19 case on November 27th.

Over the past 47 days we have worked closely with the Maine CDC and have completed 7 separate rounds of testing. We are thankful to have a wonderful community of residents and staff who were extremely cooperative and helpful throughout the process.

On behalf of the entire Woodlands Memory of Rockland team, I want to thank you for your overwhelming support, compassion and understanding during the past seven weeks. Our partnership with you to make each day the best day possible for the residents we serve has been paramount to reaching this day at Woodlands Memory Care of Rockland.
