Dear Family Members and Friends,

We are writing to update you on changes to the visitation policies at all Woodlands Senior Living communities.

As vaccination rates among residents, staff and community members continue to increase, we reviewed the restrictions that were in place and have made adjustments. The following visitation guidelines are effective immediately:

- Masks/face coverings must be worn (regardless of vaccination status) in all common areas (e.g., corridors, dining room, activity room, T.V. room, etc.).
- Appointments for visits in <u>private resident rooms</u> or <u>outdoors</u> are no longer required.
- Because we must consider the safety of non-fully vaccinated residents who may share a room with a fully vaccinated resident, we will require <u>notice</u> (versus an appointment) of your plan to visit with a resident in a shared room so that we can make appropriate arrangements in advance of the visit.
- Again, because we must consider the safety of non-fully vaccinated residents, social distancing must be maintained during visits that occur in shared common areas (e.g., dining room, activity room, T.V. room, etc.).
- If you would like to bring a pet to visit, the pet visit must be limited to a single resident. A certificate of the pet's current rabies vaccination is required.
